GS2 / 1961-62	There are about eight distinct events that take place in the video. They are:		
	1. Slewing of the Talos launcher just moments before firing. The missiles shown in the video are actually "dummies" and have no means of propulsion or warhead.		
	2. Three technicians (not sailors) are placing a warhead assembly on a test stand. This was mostlikely filmed at either Concord or Yorktown Weapons Stations.		
	3. This shows a Talos being loaded aboard by a crane, most likely at either Concord or Yorktown WepSta.		
	4. Here the Talos is being "struck down" from the 02 level atop the missile house, via an elevator, into the Missile Magazine in the Missile House.		
	5. This shows Missile House Wing & Fin Area where a team of twelve (12) Gunner's Mates and Missile Techs installed the wings and fins. I have no idea as to what the sailor in the video is doing there was no need to actuate or arm anything manually as he appears to be doing.		
	6. Here the Missile House Blast Doors are shown opening viewed from inside the Wing & Fin Area.		
	7. Here the view is of the missile coming out onto the launcher. This is the "outside" view (from the fantail), of the event shown in segment #6.		
	8. Finally the payoffThe countdown proceeds "3 - 2- 1 - FIRE", and everyone clicks their camera shutter, but too late, the missile's gone.
